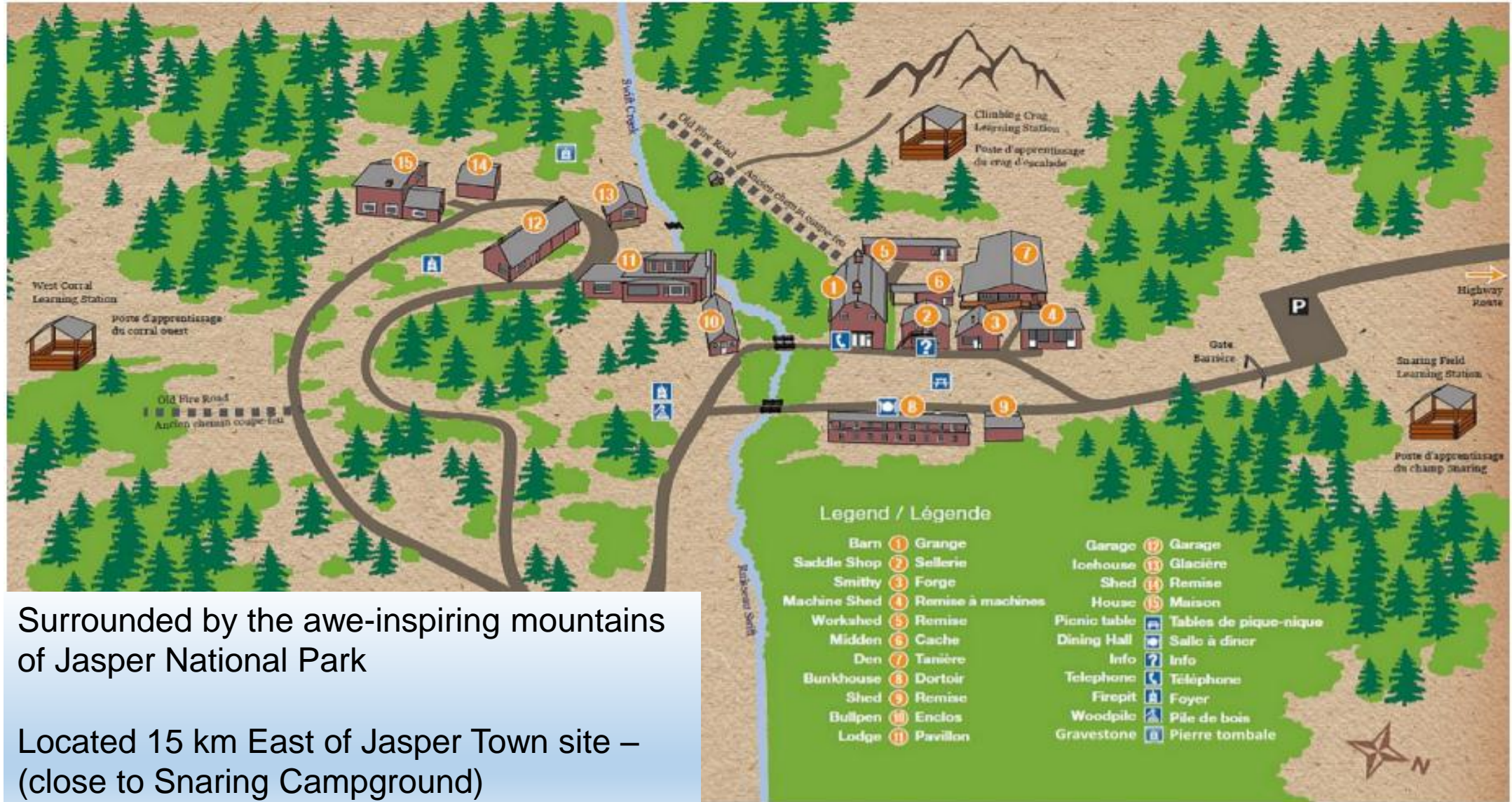

- The Palisades Stewardship Education Centre offers a broad range of programming – from four day credit courses to day programs.
- The focus is experiential education, blending mountain recreation with environmental stewardship

- **OUTSIDE!!!**
 - outdoor learning grounds and stations
 - off-site activities such as skiing, canoeing and hiking
 - three classrooms equipped with modern technology
 - fire pit area
 - Wifi is available but cellular service is not consistent



4. Who will teach me?

The Palisades Stewardship Education Centre has a skilled Education Team consisting of enthusiastic, knowledgeable and professional staff members!



5. What will I eat?

- Wonderful buffet style meals are served in the Bunkhouse Dining Room
- Arrangements for special food requirements (allergies, vegetarian, etc.) may be arranged 2 weeks prior to arrival
- The daily package includes three meals at set times
- Group leaders are encouraged to organize snacks and store them in the kitchen provided

- There are twenty-six bedrooms in seven buildings
- Sleeps over 60 people
- Students are usually housed in “The Barn” or “The Den”
- Each dorm-style bedroom has from one to seven beds
