

youth from across Canada together for a week to experience nature in a truly iconic setting. Forty participants travelled into the heart of Jasper NP, hiking, kayaking and traversing a glacier, completing the adventurous journey stage of the award.

David Livingstone: *On Mountaintop Rock*

The Palisades hosted David Livingstone School from Vancouver for a week this summer. Fifty-eight grade 7-8 students followed in the footsteps of the characters in *On Mountaintop Rock* by John McLay. The book takes place in 1950's Jasper and the kids were thrilled to see the story come to life as they explored the park. Highlights were kiteflying at Old Fort Point and meeting the author.

IFPRA Visit
